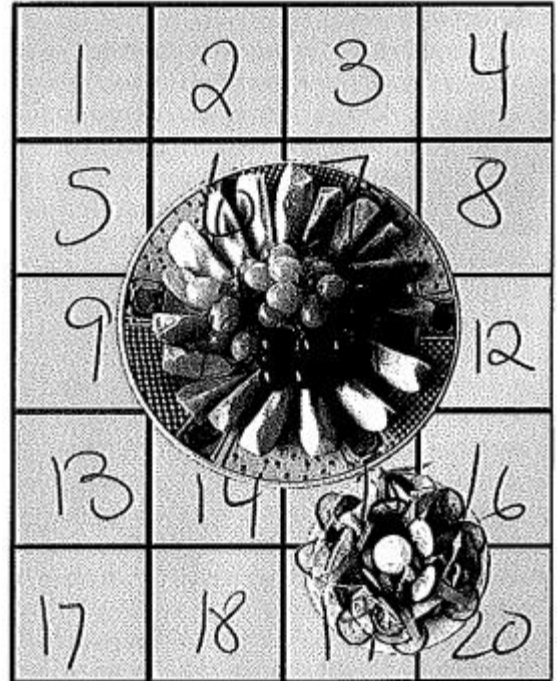


Let's Have a Picnic!

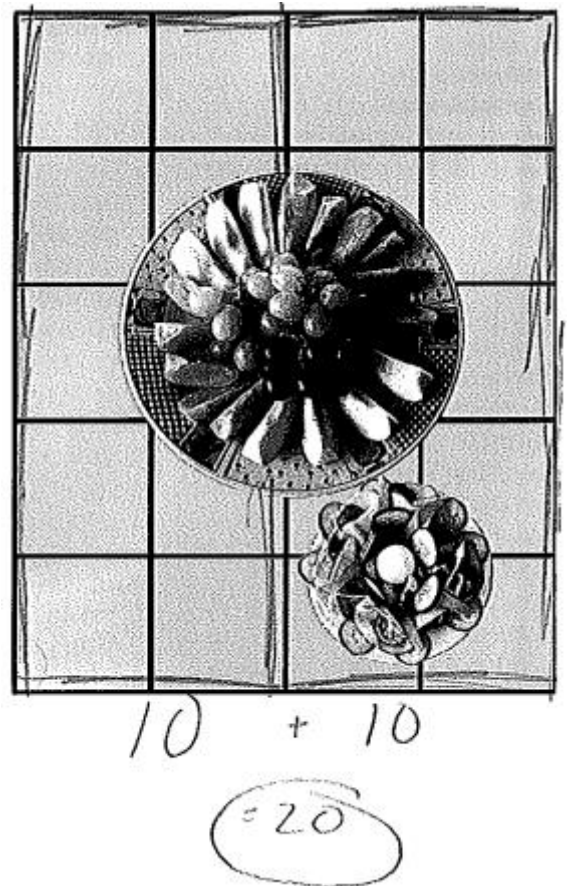
