Why Participation Matters

These are exciting times in Alberta as we move forward in the development of new curriculum that will help to prepare our students for their tomorrows. Curriculum is foundational to their futures and to the future of our province. The broad based engagement strategy planned by Alberta Education to support curriculum development is an opportunity for the many voices of stakeholder groups across the province to provide valued input into the development process.

Process for Facilitation:

- Introduce your session by explaining the opportunity that this presents for having your groups' voices heard as a source of data to help inform curriculum development in Alberta. (You may find it helpful to have pre-screened the video to assist you with this.)
- 2. Highlight the importance of sharing local views by completing the online survey. What might be important from the perspective of your school, school authority or school community?
- Watch the *Provincial Curriculum Development* Stakeholder Engagement video to become familiar with the curriculum development process, and how your group can provide input to this process through an online survey related to current curriculum.
- 4. Use the 'Questions for Discussion' to facilitate a collaborative conversation with your group.
- Use the survey link provided to access the online survey. Remind them that they will need to complete all of Part A of the survey before moving on to Part B, and that there is no SAVE function.

Session Outcomes:

Through participating in this process, participants will:

- Understand the curriculum development process.
- Understand how to complete the online survey and how their thoughts can be captured within it.
- Have collaborative conversations with colleagues to enrich the quality of their individual responses to survey questions.

Questions for Discussion:

In common subject area groupings, host a table conversation related to your current program of study.

Frame your collaborative conversations about your program of study through the following:

- I like
- I wonder . . .
- I suggest . . .

Capture your notes individually to prepare for your survey responses.
